Dear Parents and Carers,

Our Year 6 Rosebank Public School students have the opportunity to attend the Halogen Leadership Conference in Brisbane on Monday 24 February with Mrs Thomson. The Leadership Conference is a full day of presentations, workshops and inspirational speakers designed to nurture the leadership skills of our students. We have organised a bus to transport selected student leaders and supervising staff from our First North Schools.

We strongly believe in the importance of developing our student's leadership skills. Rosebank Public School is paying the \$50 entry per student to the conference. Families are being asked to pay for the coach transport to Brisbane at a cost of \$35 per student.

Halogen have been developing leadership skills in youth for over 20 years. Halogen gathers prominent leaders from all walks of life to be part of The National Young Leaders Day. The day is split into 3 sessions and each session has one or two presenters, a question time, short videos, learning experiences and student engagement activities.
