This event is for 8 -13-year-old qualifying Rosebank Public School competitors. It is being held at Clunes Public School on Monday 19 July 2021, starting at 9.30 am. ***Event order and times are estimates only and may be altered by the Carnival Manager should circumstances arise.**

Please Note: Students competing in the **Discus** will not be allowed to use a turning or spinning action when throwing, as there is no cage provided for the event (in line with **Guidelines for the Safe Conduct of Sport and Physical Activity in Schools** for Discus).

Students competing in the **High Jump** will not be allowed to use the “fosbury flop” action unless permission has been given from their school on the nomination sheet.

It is advised that if schools have not followed the **Guidelines for the Safe Conduct of Sport and Physical Activity in Schools** for High Jump (“Where appropriate, specially selected students who display promise in lead-up activities should be chosen for development in small specialised groups conducted by teachers or coaches with specific expertise in the event. All students engaged in the Fosbury Flop technique must be given adequate lead-up activities before advancing to the actual technique.”), then permission can be sought from parents to say that the student has been properly coached in the technique (possibly through Little Athletics).

Eligibility of students who are unable to attend the Carnival on the day:

Individual students are only eligible to be timed/measured if there is a clash of DoE events or special consideration. Holidays are **not** acceptable as this goes against DoE attendance policy. Times/measurements must be administered by recognised officials with the consent of the student’s Principal and the carnival convenor.
