2022 First North Athletics Carnival

Track Events at Eureka PS

Dear Parents/Carers,

The First North Athletic Carnivals are split into two days: Field Events/800m/1500m and Track Events. This consent form is for First North Athletics Carnival **Track Events at Eureka Public School on Friday 29 July 2022.**

The carnival includes a traditional March Past at 9.40 am, age races as well as ball games, novelty events for the juniors and relays. This carnival is for **all students**, Kindergarten to Year 6. There will be no supervising staff remaining at Rosebank Public School on the day.

We have been able to secure the bus to transport all K-6 students to the carnival. Families are asked to pay \$5 per student to help fund the bus. The school is covering over half of this expense. The bus will transport children directly to the carnival. It will pick students up from their bus stop and will not stop at school at 9.00am. **The bus will pass the school at approximately 8.30am for any child needing to be collected from the school site** with Mr Pescia. We will not wait for late students. Late students will need to be transported by their parent to the event. At the close of the carnival students will be transported back to school on the bus for bus lines and their normal way of departing school.

Supervising teachers will be Mrs Thomson, Mrs Astone and Mr Pescia. In the event of wet weather postponement, information will be posted on our school's closed Facebook and announced on 2LM and 104.3 radio stations after 7.30 am. The wet weather back up day is 5 August 2022.

Students must wear school uniform, including hat and appropriate footwear for sporting competition (no spikes). They must also wear sunscreen and bring a packed recess, lunch and water, and/or some money to buy food at the canteen. Upper Coopers Creek Public School P&C will be running the main canteen on the day and Eureka Public School P&C will run the smaller snacks canteen. Parents are welcome to attend the carnival.
