The First North Swimming Carnival will take place on Tuesday 8 February 2022 for students who are turning 8 years old or older this year. Due to COVID-19 safety measures being in place for the beginning of our school year, the First North Community of Small Schools Swimming Carnival will have some guidelines to follow for the carnival to take place. Please read the following information carefully.

Purpose of Activity: First North Swimming Carnival for Zone PSSA selection.

Destination: Alstonville Aquatic Centre, 13/15 Alston Ave, Alstonville.

Date: Tuesday 8 February 2022.

Staff Involved: Blake Henderson and Oliver Pescia.

Transport: Private car transport.

Cost: \$5.50 pool entry (Fitness Passport or Pool Season passes can be used).

Time: Arrive at 9:30 am for first event marshalling at 9:45am. Finish at approximately 2pm.

Dress Requirements: Swimmers, towel, change of dry clothes including underwear, sunscreen, hat and water bottle. Please come dressed ready to compete.

Food/Drink: The pool kiosk will be operating; however, we encourage students to bring their own food and drink to minimise mingling around the kiosk.

Current Safety Guidelines: Current guidelines will require spectators to sit separately from competitors. Please follow signage on the day and do not enter the school seating area. We encourage students to leave the venue after the completion of their events. Students can return to school for the remainder of the day. We are encouraging 1 spectator per competitor.

Successful competitors who meet qualifying times will be expected to represent the First North Community of Small Schools at the Northern Rivers PSSA Swimming Carnival on Tuesday 1 March 2022 at Lismore Memorial Baths. If the weather is inclement an announcement will be made on the school's Closed Facebook page.
