### School Swimming and Safety Program 2022

The School Swimming and Water Safety program will take place over 5 days starting from Monday 28 February at the Goonellabah Sports and Aquatic Centre (GSAC). This is a whole school activity where every student is expected to attend each day. No supervising staff will remain at school.

The Department of Education NSW is funding the cost of the qualified swim instructors for which we are very grateful. The remaining costs of the program include lane hire, pool entry and bus hire. We highly value this opportunity and as such the school is subsidising over half of these remaining costs. Costs to our families will be \$30 per student to participate in the program. Please note, there will be no refund available if a day is missed. This represents great value as an intensive swim program (10 lessons over 5 days), where students receive small group differentiated instruction with a qualified instructor and supervision by staff from Rosebank Public School.

#### Organisation

The bus will depart from school at 9:10 am. Children need to wear their swimming costume under their school uniform and bring underwear to change back into their school uniform after swimming. They must also wear covered school shoes. We estimate that the bus will be leaving Goonellabah at approx. 12:15pm each day to return to school.

### **Children Must Bring**

A swimming bag with underwear, towel, comb or brush, <u>plastic bag for wet clothes</u> and covered slip-on footwear e.g. crocs or canvas shoes with no laces (No thongs please).

The program will operate under COVID-19 safety restrictions at school, during bus travel and at GSAC. Please complete the attached consent form and return to the school office by Monday 21 February.
