Lismore Small School Handball Championship 2023

Dear Parents and Carers,

Our students K-6 will be participating in the Lismore Small Schools Handball Championship. Schools participating will be Albert Park, Tregeagle, Wyrallah, Rous, Lismore Heights, Corndale, Rosebank, Eureka, Eltham, Clunes and Bexhill as a reward for excellent attendance rates at their school.

Please read the following information about the day.

When: Thursday 22nd June 2023.

Where: Lismore Basketball Stadium.

Who: Kinder to Year 6 students.

Transport: CCC buses.

Start Time: Bus departs Rosebank Public School at approximately 9:00am. Handball competition begins at 10:00am. Bus departs from the venue at 2:00pm to return to Rosebank Public School.

Cost: \$7 in total (\$5 for bus transport and \$2 for the stadium hire).

What to Wear: School uniform.

What to Bring: Fruit break, recess, lunch, water bottle, hat and appropriate joggers to play handball.

Canteen: Canteen facilities are available for snack food and drinks.

There will be an opportunity to purchase a sausage sizzle for \$3.00 and a Popper for \$2.00 on the day.

Staff Attending: Mr Pescia, Mrs Astone and Mr Henderson.

Competition Details:

The event is about giving each student an opportunity to play handball, mix with students from our small schools and to have fun. There will be an opportunity for students to play in either a single or doubles events. Staff have been working with our students explaining the rules for both of these events. Students will be split into 3 age groups, Stage 1 (Years 1-2 including our Kinder students), Stage 2 (Years 3-4) and Stage 3 (Years 5-6). All students are guaranteed one game, more if they are successful and make it to the semi-finals and the final.

Handball Rules:

Singles Rules

- Matches are played on a 6 square court. Each square is 3m by 3m.
- Each player gets three lives. When they lose all three, they are out and that square becomes poison. Top place getters move straight to the final, others will get another chance to do so.
- No grabbing the ball. It must be a hit off the ball.
- No below knee serves.
- If the ball lands in your square you must hit it.

Doubles Rules

- Same as above for the most part.
- The team has three lives not each player.
- Any player can hit the ball at any time. You do not have to alternate.
