Green	Teacher re-states expectation for positive behaviour	
Orange	Explicit and Focused Teaching, often accompanied by consequences	
	Teacher discretion re referral	
Red	Escalation, referral to Principal (*Call Parent/Carer)	
	Red incidents carry the possibility of a Formal Caution or Suspension.	
	Suspensions are usually preceded by a Caution, except in the case of physical	
	violence and other serious incidents, where immediate suspension may occur	



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
