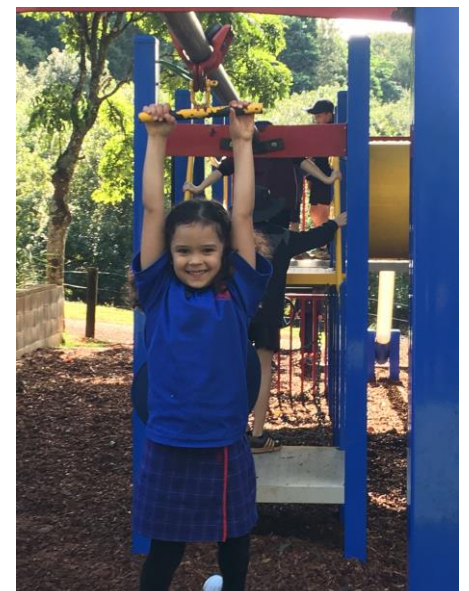

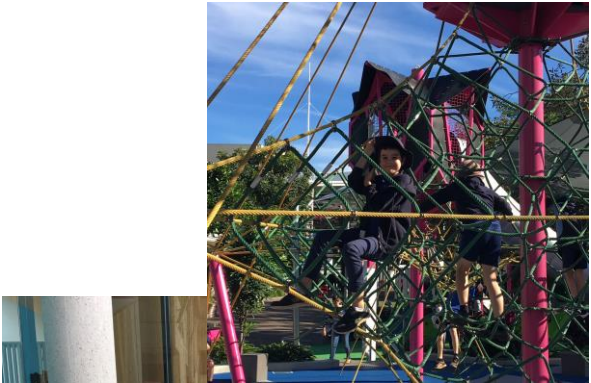
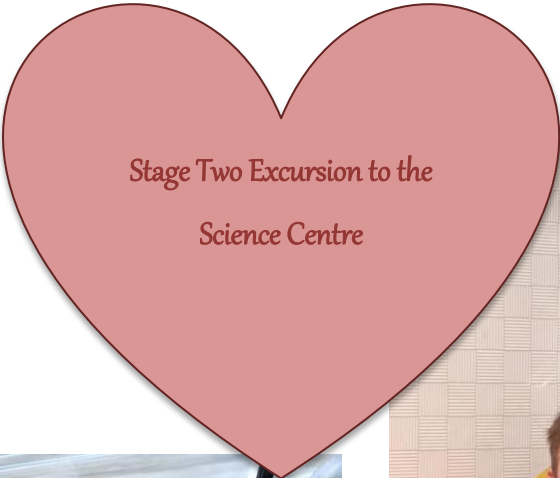
Report Season
