YOUR CHANCE: Parent Survey

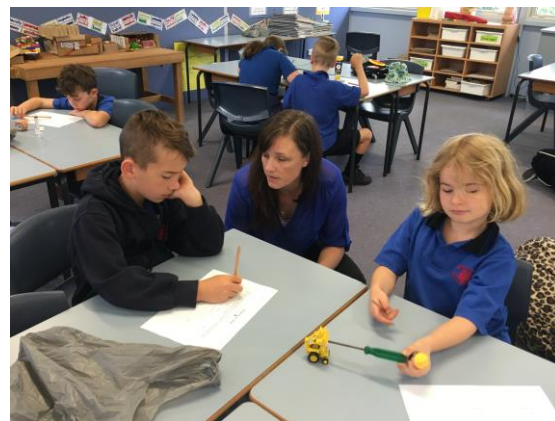
