**ICAS Tests: For your consideration...**

Each year, ICAS tests are held across Australia as an additional way of assessing children's progress at school. These tests are administered by the Uni of NSW and are opt-in, not a requirement. At Rosebank, the school pays for children to sit certain ICAS tests that will provide additional information about student learning. This year, the school will pay for all Year Four students to sit the ICAS Writing test and all Year Five students to sit the Science test. Parents who would like their child to sit additional tests (we will offer Writing, Maths and Science for Years 4 to 6) should complete the attached form and return to the office by Friday March 24<sup>th</sup>.
