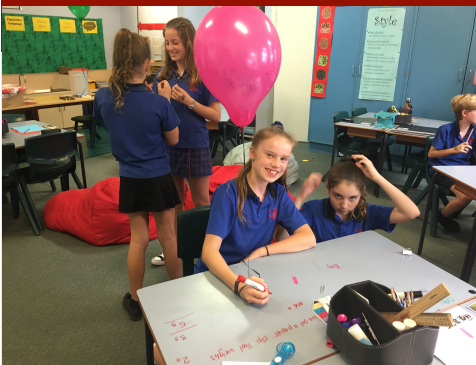

Next week, Years 3 and 5 sit the NAPLAN tests. The tests are one of the ways in which information is gathered about student learning. Data generated are used to help us plan our programs and evaluate our own performance. The children have been well prepared and have been encouraged to approach the tests feeling confident, as they have learned in *You Can Do It!* We provide water bottles and fruit for all children participating, and they have special activities after the tests on Tuesday. ACTS OF KINDESS

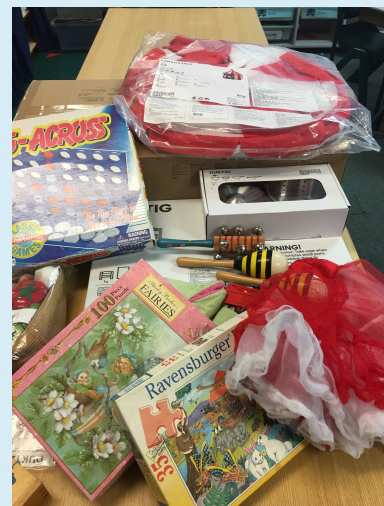
