## Reading

Reading is a fundamental skill for all students. It begins when children are young, listening to us read and talk about books and other written media. Once students start school, they are explicitly taught the phonetic code, which they apply to reading. From there, they move on to more challenging books, focusing on fluency and comprehension. We cannot underestimate the importance of developing a love for reading.

### Tips for Reading with Your Children

Make reading together a special time, free from interruptions like the television or phones. Your child will value this quality time, and it is a great way to take a break from screen time. If your child is tired or restless, keep the session short, about five minutes. When they're feeling more energetic, you can extend the time. Five to ten minutes every day is better than one twenty-minute session a week. As you read together, talk about what has happened and ask your child what they think might happen next. After finishing the book, discuss the story and ask questions about the plot and illustrations.

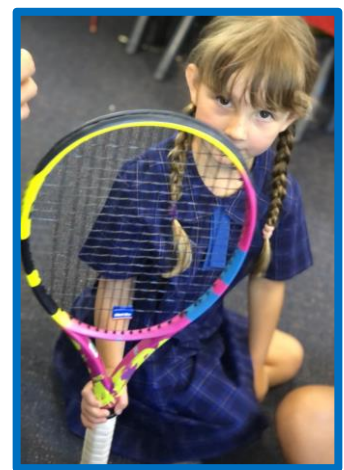
